Firefighters said that at no time during their firefighting efforts were they made aware that many of the buildings occupants might still be inside. Shortly after the fire was under control, they began a search of the building and discovered that 10 of the buildings 17 occupants had died. The floor plan in Appendix A shows the locations of the victims. They were distributed throughout the building. The same number of victims was found on the east side as the west side and in the front part of the building as the rear. Eight of the victims were found on the second floor and two on the third floor. Post mortem examinations of the victims were performed at the Office of the Wayne County Medical Examiner. Although autopsies were not conducted, blood toxicology tests were performed, and...
