In addition to that, research into metonymic relationship traditionally has been put only second to the phenomenon of metaphor. However, things have changed a little over the past decades. Especially after Lakoff/ Johnson had published their influential work on metaphor and conceptualization (Metaphors we live by , 1980) research into cognitive aspects of language gained more ground in linguistics. Deeper insight into the way we structure our perception of the world has led to the conclusion that both, metaphor and metonymy, must be regarded as cognitive phenomena. As such they illustrate the fact that fundamental cognitive abilities and experientially derived cognitive models have direct and pervasive linguistic manifestations (Langacker, 1993, p.1) and, conversely, that by ways of...
